Agreed Report
March 23rd 2026

An ordinary meeting of the Board of Management took place on Monday March 23rd 2026.

The minutes of the meeting of January 21st 2026 and February 10th 2026 were read and adopted.

The Board noted correspondence from CEIST, JMB Bulletins, relevant DES circulars and publications, SEC regarding examination fees 2026 and changes to JCPA data entry.

The Child Protection Oversight Report was presented in full compliance with the *Child Protection Procedures for Primary and Post-Primary Schools (2023)* and the *Children First Act (2015)*.

The Board received:

- An Anti-Bullying / Bí Cineálta Oversight Report
- A Code of Behaviour Report
- A Data Protection Report, confirming that no data breaches occurred during the report.

The Board ratified the School Inclusion Policy which is available to view on the School Website. The Digital Learning Plan is available for consultation. The Acceptable Usage Policy will be reviewed to include A.I. in the school context.

The Board noted activities connected with:

- The Board congratulated staff and students on the number of activities ongoing in the school.
- 'A Day in the Life' event for incoming First Year Students 2026-2027 was noted and acknowledged as a successful event.
- Congratulations were extended on the All-Ireland Soroptimist win for fifth-year student Millie Seaman. A second student, Ella McCarthy also participated in the All-Ireland event at the Mansion House in Dublin.
- Best Wishes were extended to Junior and Leaving Certificate students as they commence Oral and Practical State Examinations.

The Principal updated the Board on progress regarding communication with CEIST and a meeting with CEIST CEO in relation to the condition of the roof of the school building and a need for additional accommodation for boys' bathroom and changing facilities.
